### General Description

## Requirements

- Brevet d'Aptitude aux Fonctions d'Animateur (BAFA), Early Childhood Education (ECE) qualification, teaching degree, or other qualification related to childcare or education.
- Experience working in camps, with children, or with specific creative or sport activities.
- First aid, CPR, and additional training may be required or beneficial.
- Physical ability to participate in activities and support the weight of children.
- High level of responsibility and accountability.
- Flexible, upbeat and engaging personality.
- Strong communication, interpersonal, and leadership skills.
